AUDITORIUM: - Abraham – Terry Burton & Jerry Arnwine “It sounded crazy. God had promised Abraham, an old man with no children, that his descendants would be as numerous as the stars. Yet Abraham chose to believe God, embarking on a transforming, lifelong journey of faith and obedience. God has made promises to us as well.”

Wednesday PM – Auditorium – Leviticus – Devin LaBay – “At the center of the Pentateuch (The first five books of the Bible), is Leviticus and it reveals the heart of the Old Testament Law. Portions of the law teach the holiness God requires of His people. Other portions teach the forgiveness God offers to restore sinners to holiness. The major focus of Leviticus is “atonement”,(at-one-ment) – God’s provision for forgiveness.”
